






# The German Research System


- Federal and state governments (BMBF, BMWi, ...)

- Companies (more than two thirds of the annual funds invested in research come from industry)



# The Path to Professorship



#### Postdoc Phase (2-4 years)

#### Habilitation

- formal qualification, certifies the ability to teach in an academic subject
- 4-6 year period of independent research, teaching, and administrative responsibilities,
- treatise or several articles ("cumulatively")
- Dr. habil.

#### Juniorprofessor (W1) Jun.-Prof.

- Focus: early independence in research and teaching
- temporary professorships, up to 6 years, some offer tenure track option (W2/W3)
- don't have to write a habilitation
